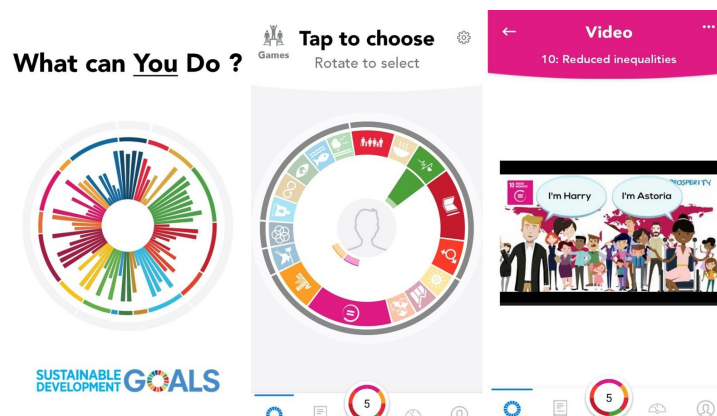

## Tesco removes 67m pieces of plastic as it scraps tinned multipacks from all its UK stores

---

“Tesco will replace plastic-wrapped multipacks with plastic-free multibuy on tinned food eliminating 350 tonnes of plastic from the environment.

Customers still get the same ‘multipack’ value, just without plastic.

183,000 tinned multipacks are bought every day at Tesco.

Today it has announced it will become the first UK retailer to remove them from all Tesco stores and replace them with plastic-free multibuy. This will see 67 million pieces of plastic eliminated.”
