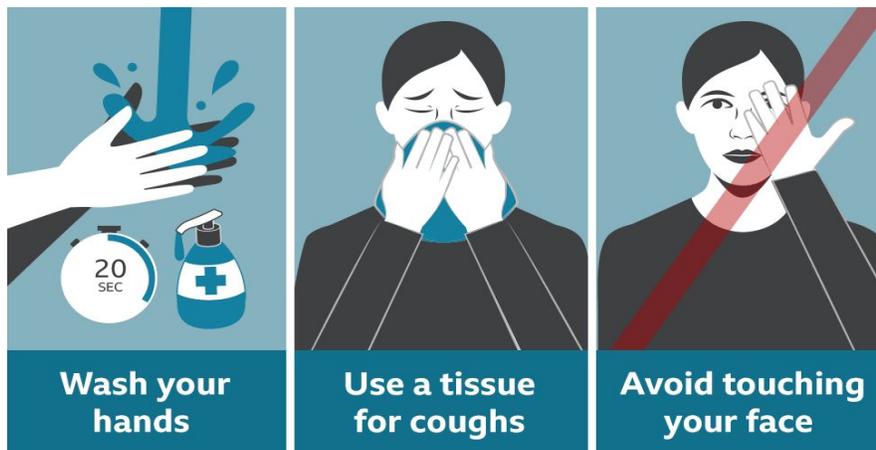

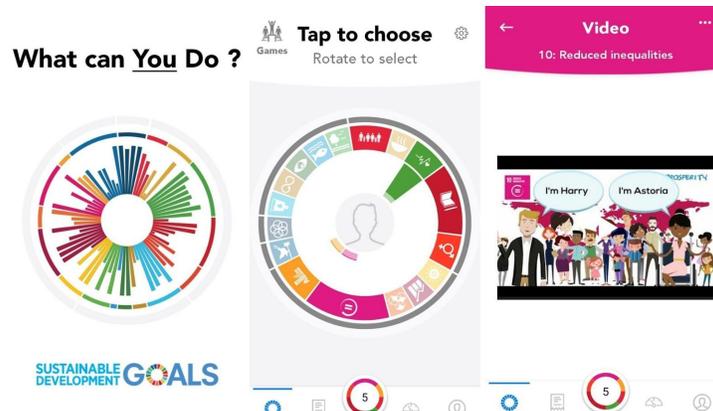

The facts

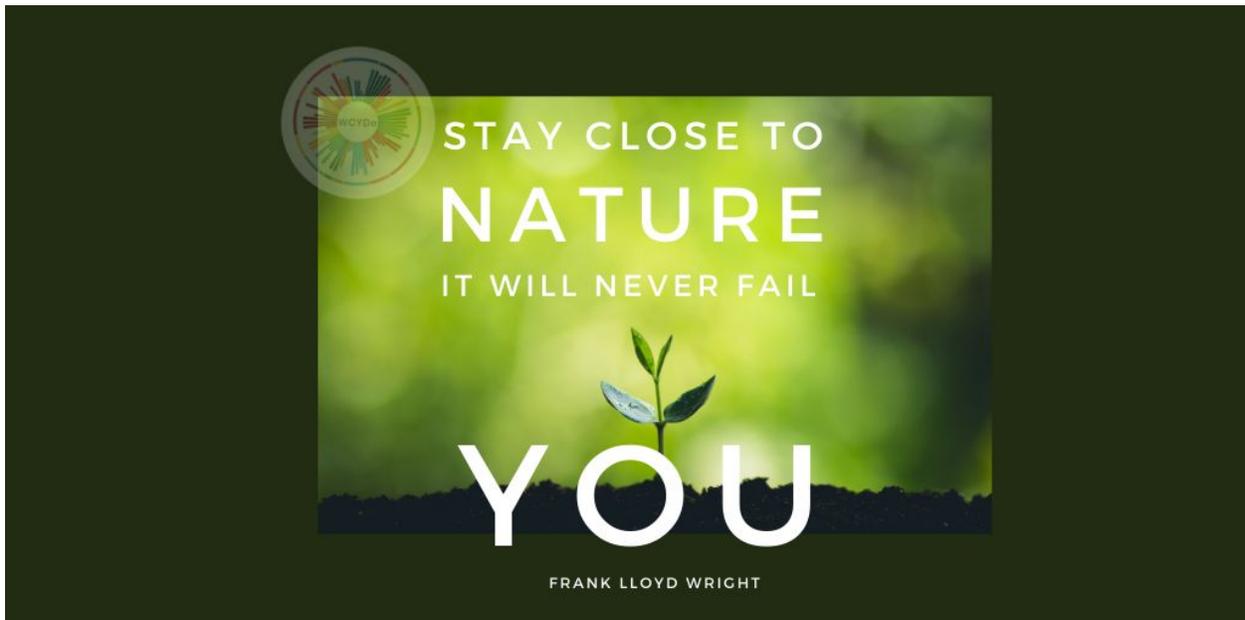
- 736 million people live in extreme poverty
